SPONSOR IS TO RETAIN THIS PORTION FOR THEIR RECORDS

Your candidate should be of the Catholic faith and be at least 21 years of age with a suggested age of 25 years or older.

Before Cursillo:

1. Pray... talk to God about the candidate before you talk to the candidate about God.
2. Give candidate general idea of what Cursillo is about and explain the 4th Day.
3. Sponsor should help candidate fill out Cursillo application (in the case of married person, complete both husband and wife forms and return together).
4. Obtain the pastors report and signature found on the reverse side of the application form.
5. Explain that there is an \$85.00 donation and its purpose.
6. Ask candidate to refrain from bringing a cell phone to the weekend. Not only is it a distraction, but this is a retreat weekend and a “closed community” where candidates are asked to leave behind their daily worries, problems, work and even family concerns. However, reassure candidate that emergency phone numbers will be listed in their confirmation letter.
7. Provide transportation to and from weekend so candidate does not arrive or go home alone.
8. Continue to Pray for your candidate throughout the weekend.

After Cursillo:

1. Remember to pick up your candidate on Sunday evening.
2. The sponsor should assist the candidate by maintaining contact in Post-Cursillo in order to help him/her grow in Christ.
3. Accompany your candidate to Group Reunion, Ultreya and School of Leaders the first few times until he/she feels comfortable.
4. Encourage him/her to persevere in their environments.
