A Search for Water Spiritual Director's Comments

The Green Bay Cursillo movement will be beginning a new era with the implementation of the two Deacon Cursillo weekends. Unfortunately, over the years, it has become harder and harder to be able to free up a priest for the weekend Cursillo and it is has been decided, through the Diocese, that we will be going forward with two deacons as spiritual directors for the weekends. Obviously, we still need to be able to rely upon our priests to do reconciliation and mass during the weekends. We have been given approval to be able to continue to use a priest if we are able to find replacements for them to be able to allow them to be away from their own parish during the Cursillo weekend.

This new process will be implemented with this falls Cursillos, both for the men's and women's. A group of four deacons have recently gotten together because we were actually going to do a trial run before the determination was made by the diocese to go this route. The four deacons (Deacons Mark Mullins, Gary Vanness, Dave Van Eperen and I) were able put a plan together for the weekends. We were able to make an exhaustive list of the requirements that will be necessary to make sure we are taking care of the spiritual needs for the weekend so the candidates will not even realize that, historically, there was always a priest on the entire weekend.

Bishop Ricken has appointed Deacon David Van Eperen from St. John's Parish in Little Chute and me as the Green Bay Cursillo spiritual directors going forward.

Deacon Mark Mullins and I will be the spiritual directors for the men's fall Cursillo that is being held at St. Nicholas Parish in Freedom. Deacons Dave Van Eperen and Gary Vanness be spiritual directors for the women's Cursillo that is being held at St. Joseph's Parish in Green Bay.

We are looking for any deacons that would be willing to act as a spiritual director on weekends. If you have recommendations, or if you are a Deacon who is interested, please contact either Deacon Dave Van Eperen or Deacon Tom Gritton.

I would also be remiss if I did not thank Father David Pleier for his years of service as the spiritual director for the Green Bay Cursillo Movement. We were in great hands with Father Dave.
