The revised translation of this book describes Days of reflection on the Founding Charism of the Cursillo held in "The Porciúncula" in Palma de Mallorca on the 50th Anniversary of the First Cursillo Weekend held in Cala Figuera in Santanyi, on the Island of Mallorca, Spain in August 1944.

The following outline is on the 5th topic, *Conviction*. There are 10 topics in the revised translation of 1st Conversations of Cala Figuera. Cursillistas are encouraged to read this topic in its entirety at the <u>Cursillo Resource Center</u>. This is a great resource for study in the School of Leaders. - All are called to tasks that demand conviction and what everyone does is to compel people to make a decision perhaps without being convinced.
- Some do not believe in the Gospel and others do not believe it to be efficient. Who defrauds God more?
- The capacity for astonishment, together with the capacity for conviction and the capacity for decision, if truly utilized, express and manifest the dimension of the person.
- Human conviction is most powerful when it is centered, unified and interlaced by the most essential reality: "God loves me personally in a singular and unique way".
- Authentic conviction is for a person, a value that does not pass, does not weigh him down nor gets in his way.
- Among the ones that believe they know and the ones that are capable of believing, these last are the ones that advance towards the full and exact fullness of their being a person.
- Man yearns for what is fundamental, not to allow himself to be diluted in peripheral behaviors, but to maintain and to impel the goals of daily living from a firm conviction rooted in reality and truth.
- Conviction is the dorsal fin of knowledge that is controlled, articulated and aimed to reside in the reality, and to be carried out as a person.
- Ignorance is a clamorous invitation to become light.
- Truthfulness is what makes your motives more profound, clear and fully alive.
