Subject:	Revised Requirements for Approval of New Regional Coordinators

The purpose of this Memo is to inform all Diocesan Secretariats and Schools of Leaders about an important revision to the Articles of Operation, Article VI-Regions, Subsection Ai-Regional Coordinator:

The Regional Service Team members, the Regional Secretariat and the Regional Spiritual Advisor select one of the Regional Service Team members to be Regional Coordinator for their language group.

Per this revision, the Regional Secretariat (Lay Directors) **and** the Regional Service Team have the important responsibility of selecting future Regional Coordinators. Therefore, this Memo and the enclosed application should be reviewed carefully by all Lay Directors and Regional Service Teams.

An application, a letter of good standing and approval from the Regional Secretariat and Executive Committee will be required for someone to be considered to serve as Regional Coordinator. These requirements were approved by the National Secretariat at the meeting held at the Seattle University in Seattle, WA.

These requirements are necessary because there is a need to understand "who" the person is before he/she becomes a member of the National Secretariat. The information will help to know and consider the person and their abilities and what the person can contribute for the good of the Cursillo Movement before they serve at the National Secretariat level. Therefore, it is essential, that Cursillistas who are selected to serve as Regional Coordinators, be fully aligned with the Foundational Charism of Cursillo and be willing to promote it, live it and share it. Regional Coordinators are the voice of the Diocesan Movements in their respective regions and a representative of the National Cursillo Movement for a period of 3 years.
