• **Log in:** please be sure to log in with the Zoom account that is registered with the email, that you registered with.

• Mute: Please be sure to keep your microphone muted during all presentations, rollos, mass, ultreya, fiesta, and songs. This will allow all participants to enjoy the rollos and live the event clearly and without interruptions. We know that you may want to sing along, please sing along, but keep your microphone muted, so we can follow the music with are friends who will be generously sharing their instrumental talent and voice with us.

Tips



- Video: In order to enjoy minimal issues with internet issues and a great experience on Zoom, we ask that you please be sure to keep your video off during all the presentations, rollos, mass, & ultreya talks.
 - <u>Tip:</u> If you hide non-video participants, that will help with your internet bandwidth and will help in having little to no internet issues for you and for those who are giving talks and presentations.




- Log into Zoom






BASIC CONTROLS

3. BASIC CONTROLS:

- ❖ MUTE: click on the little microphone to Mute yourself to eliminate surrounding noise, echo, distraction sounds during the encounter. Note: the MUTE button will only silence you and your surrounding noise, it will not mute the main speaker, so you will still be able to hear everything :)
- VIDEO: click on the little video camera to show your beautiful/handsome face. We want to meet and see all of our friends....Personal Contact
- (...) the three little dots at the upper or lower corner of your screen give you some options:
 - ➤ Chat
 - Virtual Background
 - > Reactions/Emojis
 - > Etc....

Hide Non-Video Participants:


This will help with your bandwidth & internet issues.

- ➤ To hide non-video participants:

 Click "Video" Option Arrow. Then check the box next to "Hide Non-Video Participants.
- (...) Right-click on the three little dots at the upper/the window preview of the said person in your meeting that doesn't have the video on. Then choose... Hide Non-video participants.

Show Non-Video Participants:

To see them again, click on... Total non-video participants at the top. Select Show Non-video Participants
